I trust you will not be in the hospital very long and will be home soon. I know you may be sore and scared right now, but there's no need to worry.



## WANT TO KNOW WHAT AWAITS YOU IN THE HOSPITAL AND HOW IT ALL GOES?

When you arrive at the ward, **you will wait a little while with your mommy or daddy for a nurse.**

**Do not eat or drink anything.** In the meantime, your mommy or daddy will prepare your medical records, your insurance card, and their own identity card and insurance card.



**A nice nurse will come and ask what your name is and how old you are,** and she will help you shower and change into clean clothes – pyjamas and slippers.

**The nurse will then weigh you, take your temperature, and maybe give you a special bracelet** with your name on it and show you to your room and bed.

**When you are in your room, a doctor will come and examine you, and you will talk** about what happened to you and how you are feeling.

When mommy or daddy is with you, the doctor will tell them about your illness and how it will be treated.

**There will be two rounds during the day.** These are special visits by doctors who will come to see how you are doing.



**You will have breakfast, lunch, and dinner in the ward, too.** The nurses will let you know when and where to eat, or you will eat in your room.

**If someone wants to come and visit you,** they can, but they must be over 15 years old and can only come during the specified time, **from 15:00 to 17:00.**

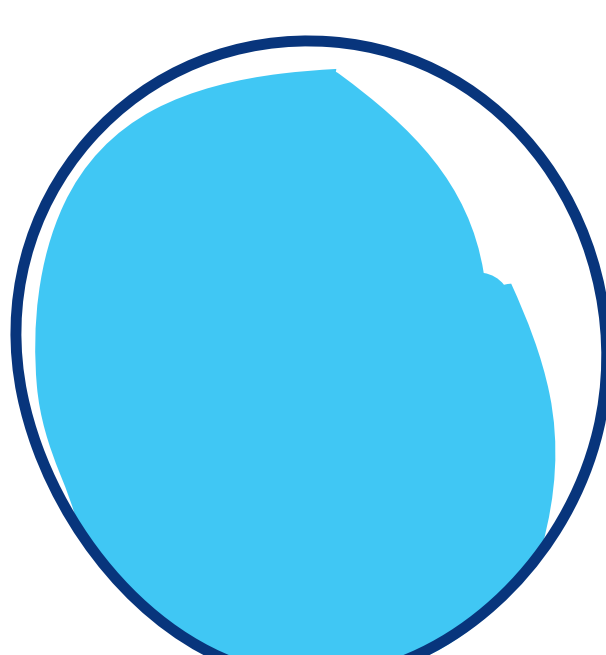
**During your hospital stay, you will have various tests done,** and based on these the doctor will determine how long you will stay in the ward.



**In case you miss school,** the Clinic has a nursery for the youngest children and a primary school for the older ones. The teachers are very nice and have cool activities for you, and you will definitely not be bored. You can play with them, make some crafts, or just talk to them.

**When you finally go home,** the doctor will tell you and your mommy or daddy what you can and shouldn't do or eat, and also when you will come back for a check-up. Follow everything so that you can heal properly.

A check-up is just a visit to the **doctor.**
